Re: DBE CERTIFICATION ANNUAL REVIEW NOTICE

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) has completed its review of the Affidavit of No Change submitted on behalf of your firm L.P. Consultants, LLC in fulfillment of its annual submission requirement. We are pleased to advise you that your firm continues to meet the eligibility criteria established by the U.S. Department of Transportation Disadvantaged Business Enterprise regulation, codified at 49 CFR, Part 26, and remain CERTIFIED as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) with CTDOT.

Your firm's certification with CTDOT will remain effective for as long as your firm continues to meet all DBE certification eligibility requirements and the ownership and control of the firm, upon which DBE certification was granted, has not changed. Failure to adhere to these requirements may result in the removal of DBE certification status. Your firm's next annual submission will be due on or before April 9, 2015.
